## **Saturday 9 September, 2023**

### **Thursday 7 September, 2023**

Cloudy. Today was arrival day, and we had pick-ups from the airport spread throughout the day.

### **Friday 8 September, 2023**

The first full day of the tour, and it started cloudy and cool. The group was downstairs and ready for breakfast promptly at 8:00 am. After our meal, Fredy arranged for a van and we departed from the hotel to explore the enchanting Botanical Gardens. Although the weather was a bit chilly, we were fortunate enough to spot five different butterfly species. Leaving the garden at noon, we returned to the hotel to pack our belongings before heading to the airport for our flight to Putumayo.

We departed from Bogotá at approximately 3:00 pm and landed in Villa Garzon just after 4:00 pm. Squeezing into a van, we made our way to the comfortable Posada Turística Dantayaco. Everyone was pleased with the accommodations and we enjoyed a delightful dinner at 8:00 pm at the lodge.

We awoke to heavy rain in the morning, causing us to seek shelter in the lodge's dining area. Despite the weather, we were able to spot some interesting species such as *Calpododes hewitsoni*, *Melanis smithiae xarifae*, and *Methona confusa* during breaks in the weather. Once the rain subsided, we made our way to the Mocoa River. Although it started off cloudy, the sun eventually emerged and we were able to observe an impressive total of 78 species, including *Callicore lyca*, *Panacea prola*, *Hamadryas chloe*, and *Rekoa meton*.

## **Sunday 10 September, 2023**

Another very rainy day with no end in sight. We sat around the lodge trying to maintain a hopeful attitude for a while but finally decided that this might be the perfect day to visit Mocoa and search for chocolate or souvenirs. After our visit to town we stopped for a big lunch at Tardes Campestres. When we returned to Posada Dantayaco the weather was a bit more favorable so we decided to take a short walk by the river to see if we could turn up any butterflies. During our walk we found a cooperative Yellow-patched Metalmark and our first of two *Menelaus Morphos* seen on our trip.

## Monday 11 September, 2023

Today we awoke to perfect weather and the promise of lots of butterflies. The air was warm and the sun was out! After breakfast, we loaded up in three taxis for the short drive to Centro Experimental Amazonico (CEA) where we were greeted in the parking lot by *Asterope leprieuri optima*. A great start to the day!



After the excitement in the parking lot, we were all eager to get into some quality habitat and find some butterflies. Fredy went ahead of the group to put out some bait, or “perfume” as he affectionately calls it. The group caught up to Fredy at his first baited area where we excitedly chased several species of glasswing butterflies, including *Godyris zavaleta zavaleta* and *Pteronymia primula*. We then moved further along the path to the next series of baits. This section was incredibly productive. We managed to find seven species of *Heliconius* butterflies, five species of *Anteros* (or “Fancy Pants” as the group dubbed these butterflies), six species from the subfamily *Euselasiinae*, five species of *Eunica*, and the flashy green *Evenus batesii*.



We eventually made our way to our final section of forest for the day. We were able to add several other butterflies to our list here such as *Stalachtis calliope voltumna*, *Doxocopa zunilda felderi*, *Dynamine vicaria hoppi*, *Tigridia acesa latifascia*, *Haetera piera negra*. This is also the spot where we had our first sighting of the amazing *Prepona (Agrias) claudina lugens*. What a stunner! This happened to be the biggest day of the tour ending with 122 species currently on the list.





## Tuesday 12 September, 2023

Another fantastic butterfly day, so we decided to make the long walk up Fin del Mundo to try for one of the main targets of the tour, the endemic *Callicore* ines. After fueling up with a hearty breakfast, we left the grounds of our lodge and made the short walk down the road to the trailhead. We crossed the Dantyoaco River and began our arduous hike. Our group quickly split up, with Fredy leading the way to the top and Rob and Hernan taking the the second group up.

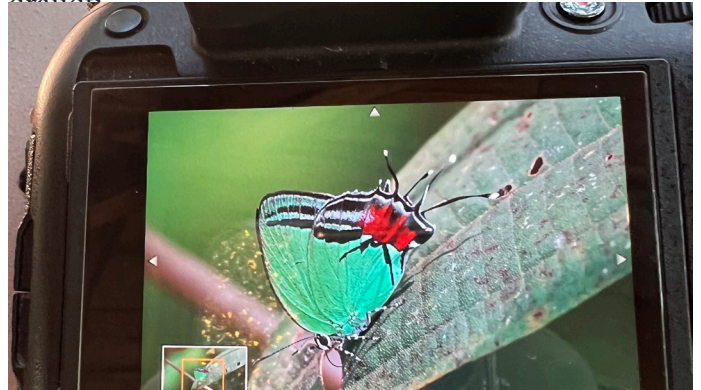
The second group had an early sighting of *Callicore* ines about halfway up the climb.



At the ridge the group found another *Callicore* ines, *Lasia agesilas*, *Anteros renaldus*, as well as many others.



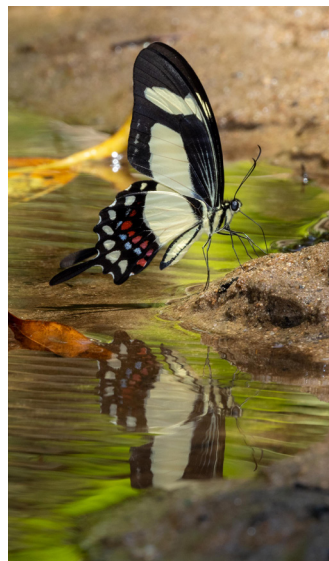
We decided to split up again and a portion of the group decided to descend the ridge and venture further along the trail. While the group that chose to continue on added *Baeotus japetus* and *Morpho menelaus*, they did miss out on a great find back at the ridge. This back of the camera image is the closest that some of got to the stunning *Annamaria drouotti*.



We climbed about 1000 ft in elevation, walked about 5 miles, and saw 119 species. A tough yet rewarding day! We arrived back at Posada Turistica Dantyoaco at 4:30 pm, cleaned up, and had an early dinner.

## Wednesday 13 September, 2023

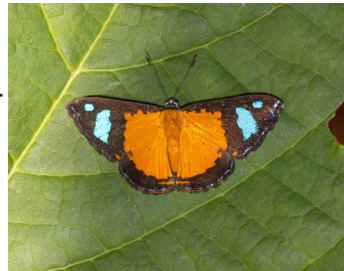
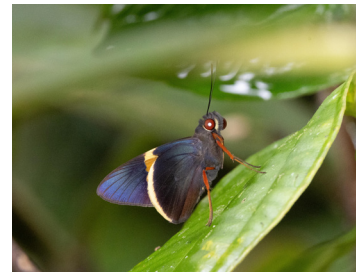
Following a challenging climb yesterday, we opted for a more relaxed day. Setting off from Posada Turistica Dantyoaco after a satisfying breakfast, we proceeded through Villa Garzon towards a location called La Castellana. This route offered a relatively leveled path with a few fascinating creek crossings. Along the way, we encountered 5 different species of *Marpesia*, at least two more *Prepona* (*Agrias*) *claudina lugens*, and an abundance of other remarkable finds.





### Thursday 14 September, 2023

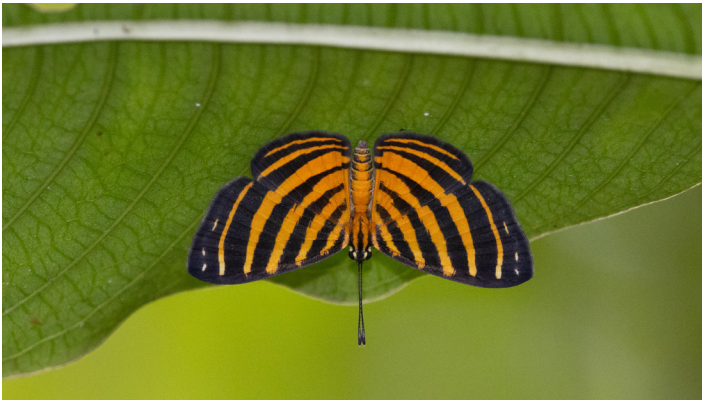
Lots of rain this morning so we spent the morning lounging around the lodge. The rain finally stopped and the sun popped out around 2:00 pm giving us a small window to get out and find some butterflies. We left the lodge and veered off the main road near Tardes Camp-estres. Upon reaching the Mocoa River, we stopped and proceeded over the river to the trailhead for Canalen-dres. Fredy began his baiting with the group not too far behind on the nice concrete path. It was during this time that Fredy spotted a *Orses cynisca*, a lifer for him. Continuing on the path, we came across *Tarsoctenus corytus corba* enjoying minerals from a bird dropping on the path. On our way back down, we were treated to wonderful sightings of several species of *Anteros* ("Fancy Pants") butterflies, as well as a stunning metal-mark called *Argyrogrammana nurtia ludibunda*. After we crossed back over the river, we decided to walk to Tardes Campestris for dinner, and afterward, we hailed a taxi back to the hotel where we indulged in ice cream and went over our list.



## Friday 15 September, 2023

After some morning rain and a late breakfast, we finally arrived at CEA. Unfortunately, the trail we had planned to explore for butterflies was too slippery from recent rainfall. We decided to take the path we had previously taken on our first visit. Fredy took the lead and started baiting the path, beginning from the parking lot all the way to the garden area. We diligently worked this area until it was time for our two o'clock taxi pickup. We had more great looks at several *Anteros* species, *Lyropteryx apollonia diana*, and *Hyphilaria parthenis*

We then made our way back to Posada Dantyaco to collect our belongings and hastily packed everything into two taxis. The ride to the airport was a bit cramped, but we managed to make it on time. The check-in and luggage inspections proved to be interesting but slow. Thankfully, our flight back to Bogota was uneventful, but it did leave us a little behind schedule. Upon arrival, we retrieved our luggage and quickly grabbed a bite to eat, enjoying some empanadas and Subway sandwiches. We bid farewell to Linda and Caydee before hopping into two taxis and heading back to Hotel El Campin for a few hours of much-needed sleep before our flight to Santa Marta.





## Saturday 16 September, 2023

Early wake-up call at 4:30 for our airport pick-up. The same two drivers from yesterday were there. We arrived at El Dorado Airport just after 5 am, checked in for our flight, and grabbed a quick snack and coffee. By 8:30, we landed at Simon Bolivar Airport in Santa Marta, collected our bags, and waited for the van to take us to our lodge. While waiting, we spotted some Great-tailed Grackles and Brown Pelicans.



The ride to our lodge was eventful - we made a stop at a grocery store for drinks and snacks, and took a few unexpected detours. However, we eventually arrived at Colores de la Sierra, our lodge.



After getting checked in and dropping off our luggage, we had a delicious lunch at the lodge's restaurant. During lunch, the clouds started rolling in, but we managed to squeeze in a short butterfly walk before the rain began. Around the grounds of the lodge we added *Heraclides thoas nealces*, *Detritivora cleonus*, *Emesis ocyptore aethalia*, *Cupido comyntas texana*, *Anthanassa drusilla drusilla*, and *Cissia pseudoconfusa*.



We made it back to our rooms just before the rain started. We met back at the dining area at 6:30 pm for dinner. The dining area was bustling and loud, so we decided to review the checklist tomorrow. Before returning to our rooms, we discussed tomorrow's plan. We were all exhausted.

## Sunday 17 September, 2023

We kick-started the day with a delicious breakfast at 6:45 am and quickly hopped into our trusted Toyota Land Rovers by 7:40 am heading up to Reserva Natural El Dorado.

Our first stop in the reserve was to set out some bait, hoping to attract the rare *Perisama oppelii mairae* on our way back down. The rugged road ahead required the high clearance of our Toyotas, but we navigated it successfully and arrived at our destination by 9:45 am.

Near our parked trucks, we spotted the endemic *Perisama nevada*, *Doxocopa cherubina*, *Adelpha seriphia egregia*, and *Marpesia corrina*. Excited to explore further, we ventured up the mountain, adding several Satyrs to our ever-growing list of sightings.

As we continued our hike, the trucks passed us, and we caught up with them to grab a quick snack. Then, we veered off the main track to search for the endemic *Aerardaris aerate* in some forest openings. The descent proved to be moderately challenging, with a few obstacles along the trail.

To our surprise, we encountered some cows grazing, blocking our path at the first opening. While the weather conditions were not ideal, with clouds rolling in from the Caribbean and obscuring the sun, we persisted. The team decided to head back up the mountain, hoping for better butterfly sightings.

Just as we were making our way back, the sun broke through the clouds, and our guide, Fredy, spotted the remarkable *Aerardaris aerata*. We were all thrilled to witness it and managed to get decent looks, despite the challenging location for photography. As we focused on capturing photos, we were surprised yet again by the sight of a second one.

On our way back to the main track the weather took a turn for the worse with increasing cloud cover and impending rain, so we hastened our descent down the mountain.

Luck was on our side as the rain began just as we reached the trucks.

After we left the rough reserve road, we made a stop for “meat snacks” and were brought out two large plates of steak, pork, and sausage.

We made our way back to the lodge for a bit of before dinner and the checklist.



## Monday 18 September, 2023

We had a delicious breakfast at Colores de la Sierra and were ready to go by 8:00, hopping into the trucks. Our expedition led us away from the lodge and up the mountain. Our journey took a turn when we encountered a locked gate at the first village, forcing us to find an alternative location. However, with the help of some locals, we managed to obtain a key to the gate and resumed our original plan.

Passing through the gate, we drove through a coffee plantation, only to be faced with another obstacle - a washed-out road preventing us from reaching the forested area we desired. Undeterred, we continued on foot, with our guide Fredy leading the way. Along the trail, we were treated to the sight of a *Caligo Atreus* butterfly feasting on bananas and a Crowned Woodnymph Hummingbird bathing in the stream. Further down the path, we were captivated by our first glimpse of the beautiful *Morpho rhodopteran* butterfly. Determined to get closer to these stunning creatures, we found a spot by a large river and set out bananas as bait. Though we observed at least four *Morphos*, they remained elusive and never settled down.

As we waited for the butterflies, the clouds began to gather and rain was imminent. Realizing our time was up, we made our way back to the trucks just as the rain started pouring. Back at Colores de la Sierra, we enjoyed a delicious lunch. In the afternoon, we



embarked on a butterfly and bird walk, where we were fortunate to add a couple of butterfly species to our list, including the incredible hairstreak, *Atlides bacis*. The day concluded with a satisfying dinner and species tally at Colores de la Sierra.

## Tuesday 19 September, 2023

Our day began with an early bird walk in the grounds of Colores, followed by a delicious breakfast.

As we set off on our adventure, we took a scenic route that led us back into the habitat of the beautiful *Morpho rhodopteran* butterflies. We were lucky enough to witness a rare sight a pair of *Morpho rhodopteran* butterflies in the midst of mating.



While we were waiting on *Morpho rhodopteran* to land for photos, we were buzzed by *Prepona hewitsoni* and just as it was about to settle a truck came by and spooked it off. Other new finds for the day include *Arawacus dumenilii* and *Strymon yojoa*.



Around noon, we noticed the clouds gathering and made the decision to conclude our day's activities. We returned to Colores de la Sierra for lunch and then packed up our belongings. At 3:00, we gathered with our suitcases and loaded them into the hotel van as we prepared to make our way to Palomino. By 6:00 pm, we had arrived at the picturesque Palomino Sunrise lodge, where we settled in and convened for a delightful dinner at 7:00. The highlight of the evening was celebrating John Crosby's birthday with a scrumptious chocolate cake



### Wednesday 20 September, 2023

After a satisfying breakfast at Palomino Sunrise, we packed up the van and made our way to Tayrona National Park, which was about an hour's drive away. The park entrance was quite busy and our guide, Fredy, had to navigate some obstacles to get us access. After about 30 minutes, we finally entered the park.

Unfortunately, we were informed at the gate that the trail we had planned to explore was closed. However, we made the most of the situation by exploring the road near the parking lot. Despite Fredy's efforts to attract butterflies with his world renowned "perfume", they seemed to be elusive. We didn't find much along the road, so we decided to seek out a new spot.

While walking to another section of the park, we encountered a worker who informed us that the trail that we initially wanted to explore, was in fact open. We gave it a try, but had similar results to the road - very few butterflies. However, we did come across a *Perrhybris pamela bogotana*, one *Itaballia pandosia pandosia*, a large troop of Capuchin monkeys and several Great Anis.

By noon, it was time to head back to the airport to catch our flight to Bogotá. We were transferred back to El Campin and opted for a pizza dinner.



## Thursday 21 September, 2023

We met in the lobby of El Campin for breakfast at 7:00 am. Afterwards, we hopped into our van by 7:45 for an incredible butterfly adventure. We drove southwest out of Bogotá towards the beautiful Tequendama area, passing by the impressive Salto de Tequendama waterfall along the way. We made a pit stop at Parador La Esmeralda for a delicious meal of sausages, arepas, drinks, and a bathroom break.



Once refueled, we ventured down a road that lead to a hydroelectric plant, where we were greeted by a stunning display of butterflies. The weather was perfect and the butterflies were out in full force, allowing us to discover several species of beautiful glasswings.

For lunch, we had a special treat awaiting us at Fredy's mom's house, just a short distance away. His mother prepared a mouthwatering chicken soup.



After lunch, we continued our search for butterflies until 3:00 pm, when we started our journey back to Bogotá. Some of the highlights seen were *Catasticta prioneris prioneris*, *Theritas paupera*, *Memphis pseudiphis*, *Lycorea ilione lamirus*, *Dircenna adina*, *Eutresis hypereia*, *Pteronymia artena*, *Pteronymia medellina*, *Ithomia terra terra*, and *Agara perissodora*.
